- 3. Be physically able to work.
- 4. Be available and willing to accepsuitable employment if offered.
- 5. Make a reasonable and sincere effort to find a job.

Reasons an unemployed person may not be eligible for unemployment benefits are:

- 1. Separation from employment ue to quitting without good cause.
- 2. Being discharged for misconductn connection with your work.
- 3. Refusal of an offer of suzzble work without good cause.
- 4. Giving misinformation or withholding information about the reason for separation from your job.
- 5. Failure to properly report wages.
